## Chronic Candida Infection: (Table 9 & 10)

- \* One of the most common chronic findings in individuals with low immune function.
- \* Lives normally in the intestinal tract.
- \* However, can overgrow, leading indirectly to significant disease or directly by invading body tissues.
- \* Candida overgrowth is now becoming recognized as a complex medical syndrome known as chronic candidiasis or the yeast syndrome.
- \* Best diagnosis criteria is detailed history and questionnaire.
